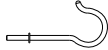
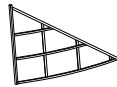
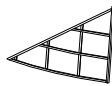
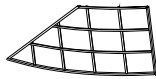
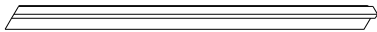
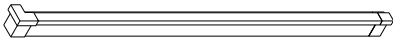
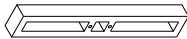
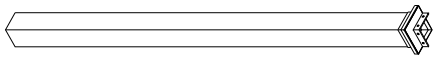
- Read and follow all Warnings & Assembly Instructions before attempting to assemble.

- Check all bolts for tightness before use, and periodically check and tighten bolts as necessary.

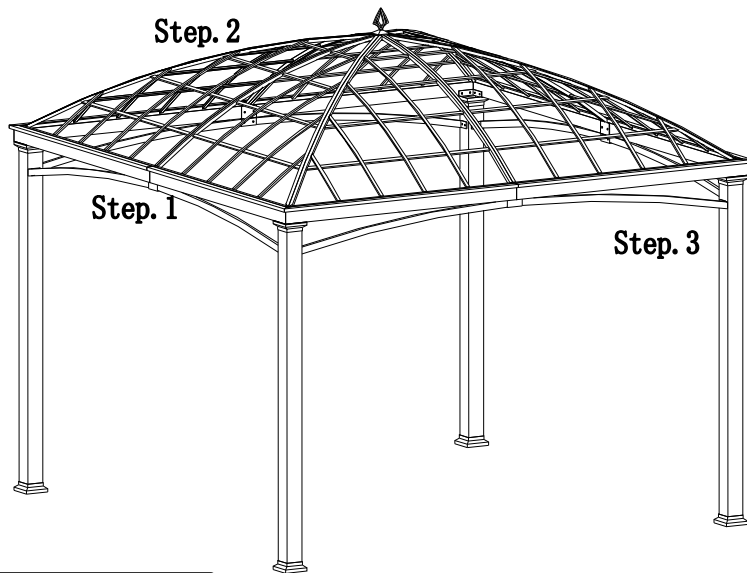

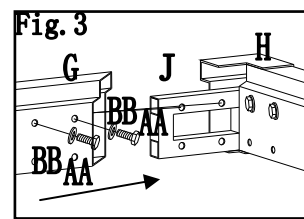
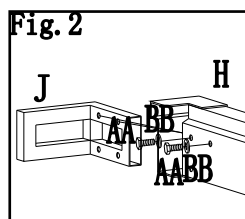
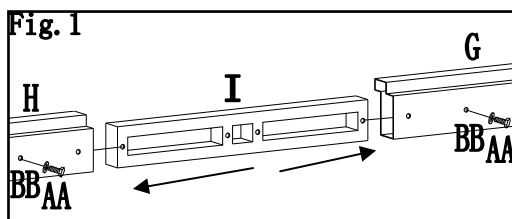
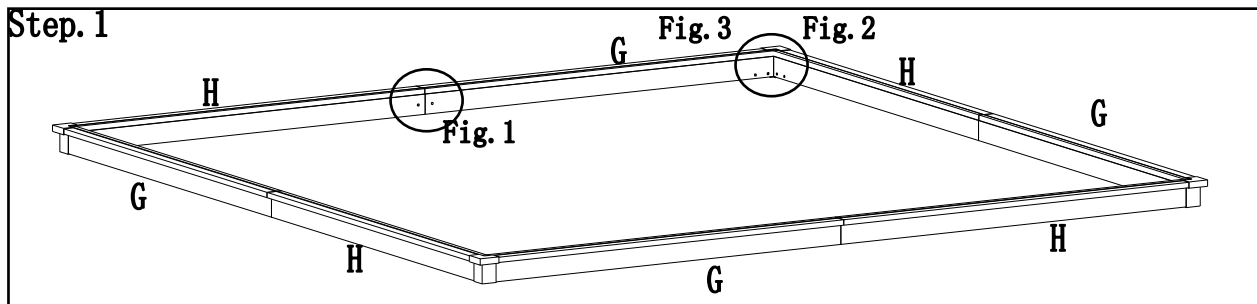
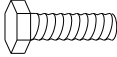
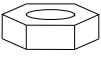
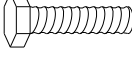


Fig.1: Insert Middle Connecting (I) into Support Beam 1 (G) and Support Beam 2 (H) using Bolt (AA) and Washer (BB).

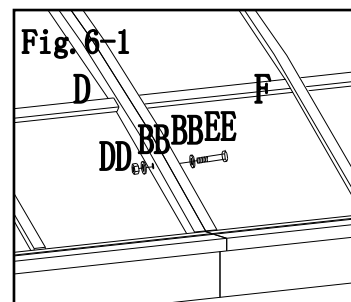
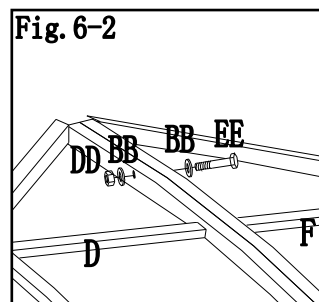
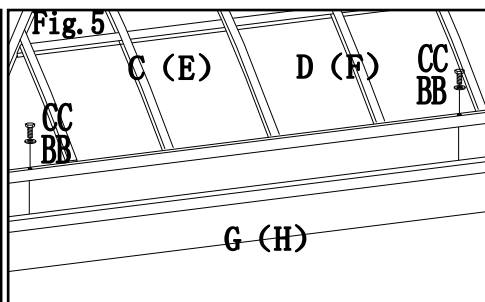
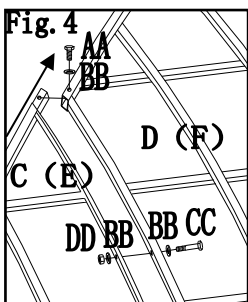
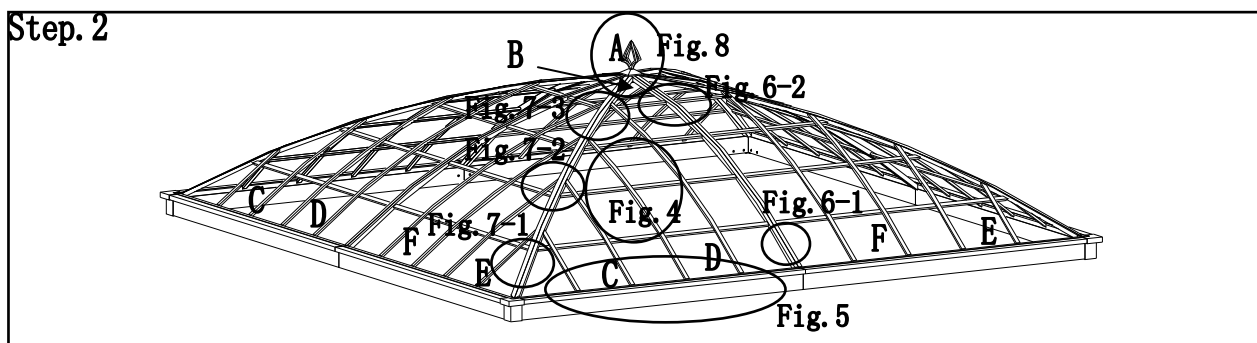


Fig.4: Insert Top Frame 1(C) into Top Frame 2 (D). Use Bolt (AA) and Washer (BB) to fix-up. Then use Bolt (CC) , Washer (BB) and Nut (DD) to lock tight. Use the same method to attach Top Frame 3 (E) to Top Frame 4 (F).

Fig.5: Use Bolt (CC) and Washer (BB) to fix assembled top frame onto Support Beam.

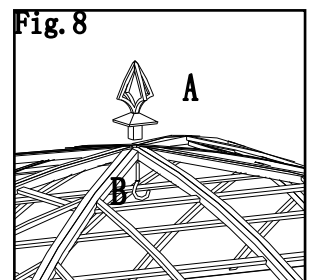
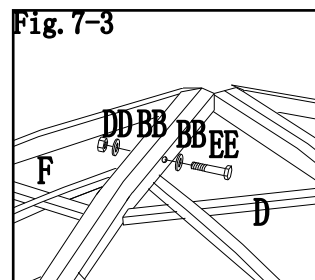
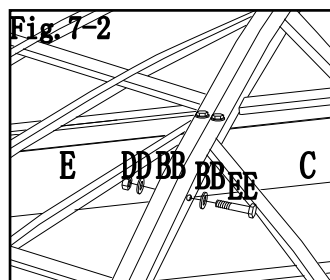
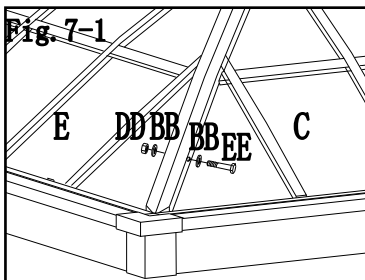
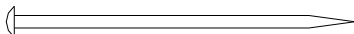


Fig.7-1, Fig.7-2, Fig.7-3: Use Bolt (EE), Washer (BB) and Nut (DD) to connect Top Frame 1 (C) and Top Frame 3 (E).

Fig.8: Insert Finial (A) into the center of the top. Then screw on Hook (B).

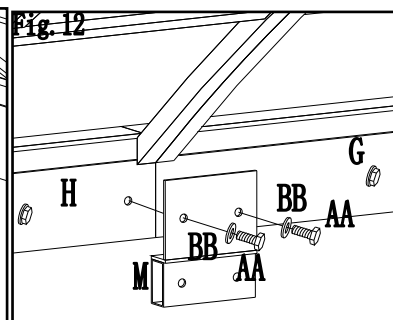
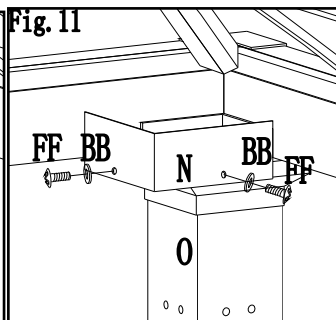
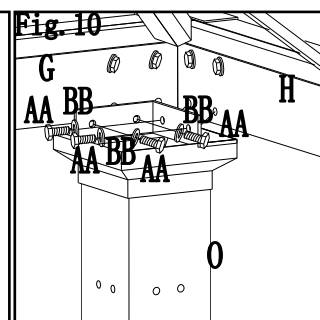
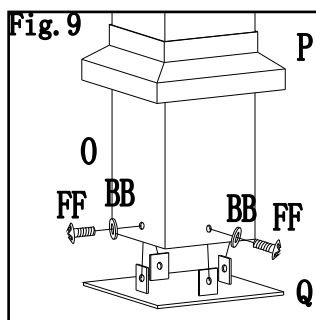
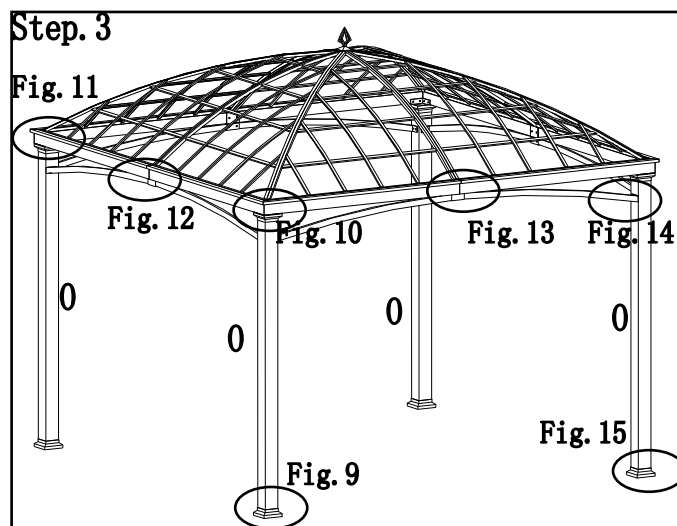


Fig.9: Lift up Stake Lid (P) firstly, then use Bolt (FF) and Washer (BB) to fix Stake Flake (Q) to Column (O).

Fig.10: Use Bolt (AA) and Washer (BB) to lock Column (O) to the outside corner of Support Beam.

Fig.11: Use Bolt (FF) and Washer (BB) to lock Baffle (N) to the base of Column (O)

Fig.12: Use Bolt (AA) and Washer (BB) to fix Arc Support Connecting (M) to the Support Beam.

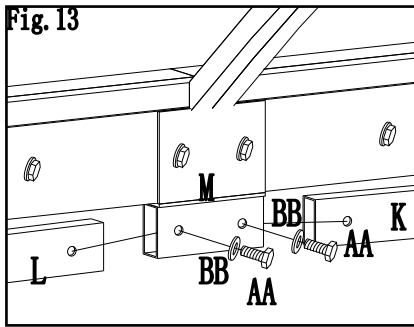


Fig.13: Use Bolt (AA) and Washer (BB) to fix Arc Support Bar 1 (K) and Arc Support Bar 2 (L) to Arc Support Connecting (M).

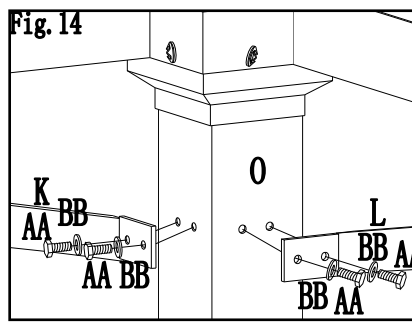


Fig.14: Use Bolt (AA) and Washer (BB) to fix (Arc Support Bar 1 (K) and Arc Support Bar 2 (L) to the other side of the Column (O) .

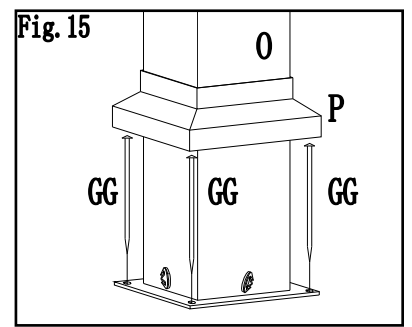


Fig.15: Use Stake (GG) to fix-up the assembled Pavilion to the grassplot. Assembly Completed!

Care & Maintenance

Before using, clean the Pavilion completely with a soft dry towel. Do not place your Pavilion in wet conditions where there is a risk of rust developing. When not in use, wipe free of any dirt or loose objects, wash with a mild solution of soap and water; rinse thoroughly and dry completely. Do not use strong detergent or abrasive cleaners.

Limited Warranty:

Sunjoy Industries warrants to the original purchaser that this item is free from defects in workmanship and materials for a period of 2 year from the date of purchase, provided the item was factory-sealed at the time of purchase and is maintained with care and used only for personal, residential purposes. Should any manufacturing defect arise within this warranty period, Sunjoy Industries will repair or replace (at our option) any defective merchandise upon proof of purchase; however, transportation and delivery costs, as well as payments to a third party for assembly or disassembly of the item, remain the responsibility of the purchaser. A purchaser of an "open box," previously-returned, or "clearance" item, as well as original purchasers outside of the warranty period, may obtain replacement parts from Sunjoy Industries for products in current production, at nominal cost.

Exclusions:

Items used for commercial, contract, or other non-residential purposes, or items damaged due to acts of nature, vandalism, misuse, or improper assembly are not covered. Corrosion or rusting of hardware is not covered. Proof of purchase (dated register receipt) is required for warranty claims. Warranty is to the original purchaser and is non-transferable. Any replacement of warranted items will be in the original style and color, or a similar style and color if the original is unavailable or has been discontinued. As some states do not allow exclusions or limitations on an implied warranty, the above exclusions and limitations may not apply. This warranty gives you specific rights, and you may also have other rights, which vary from state to state.
