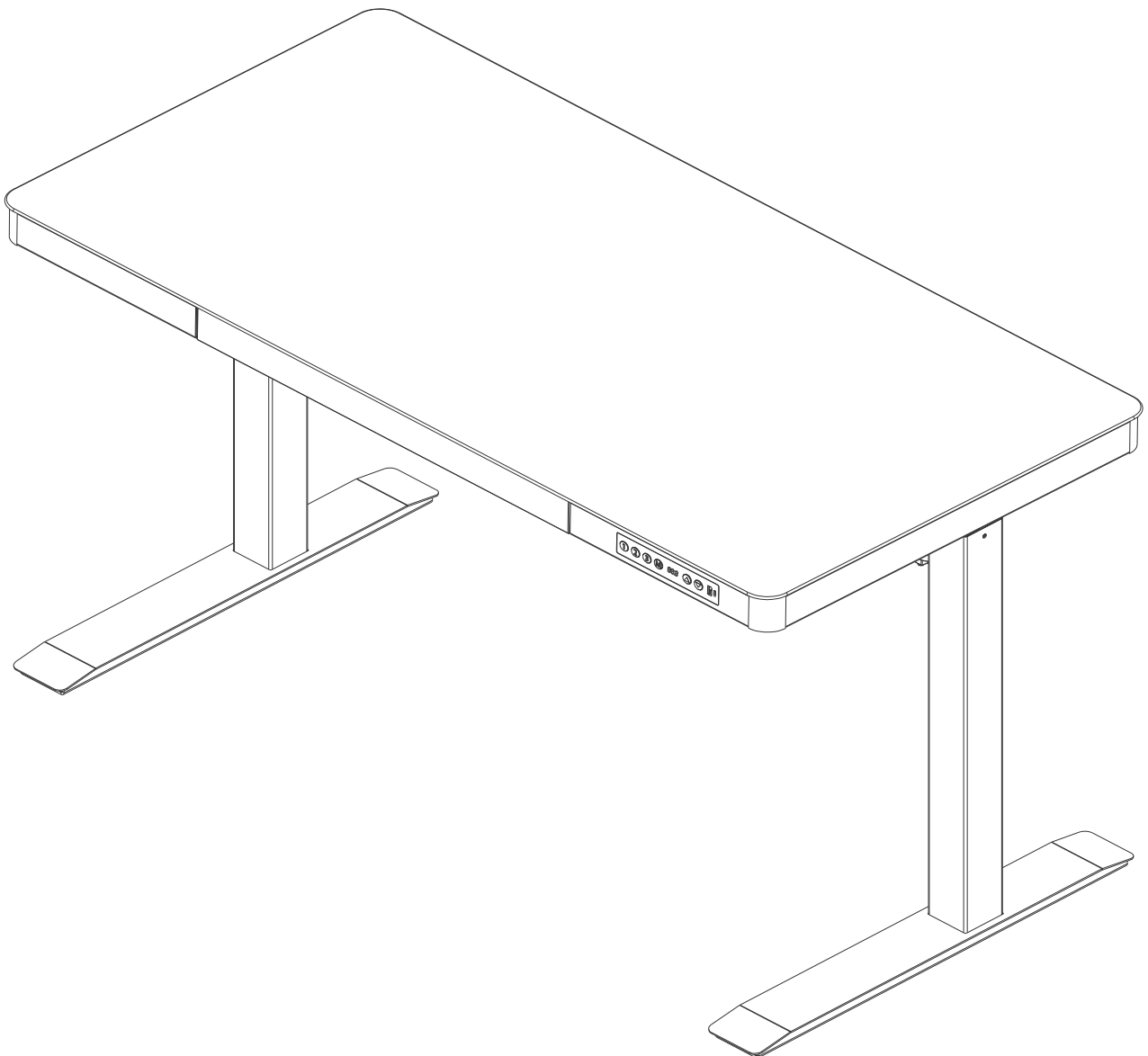

Before You Begin

Layout all components and hardware. Visually examine and make sure components are free of damage. If there is visual damage to any component, it must not be installed.

Two people are needed to turn or move the desk and some of its components. When moving or turning the assembled desk, grab the legs, not the desk top.

Make sure to assemble on a soft and non-abrasive surface to avoid scratches.

Check all connections and cables. Make sure the desk is connected to a power outlet.

If the LED Control Panel makes unusual noises or emits an odor, switch power off immediately.

The desk MUST be RESET before first use.



Read the RESET portion prior to operation (page 10).

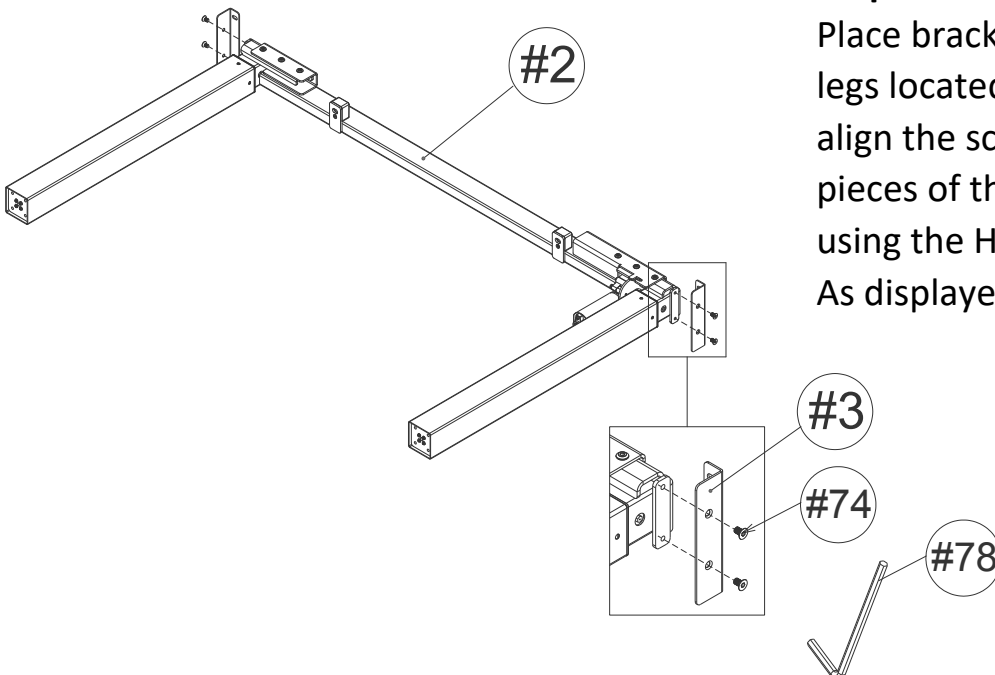
Step 1: Remove Legs/Beam (#2) from the box

Take out the Legs/Beam (#2) and move to a nearby worktable. Note that the center beam will be connected to the base of the Top Frame (#1) later in this guide. The side that features the motor is the right side.



Step 2: Install Bracket (#3)

Place bracket (#3) to each end of the legs located on the Legs/Beam (#2), align the screw holes and use 4 pieces of the M6 x 10L screw (#74) using the Hex Key (#78) to tighten. As displayed in the left image.

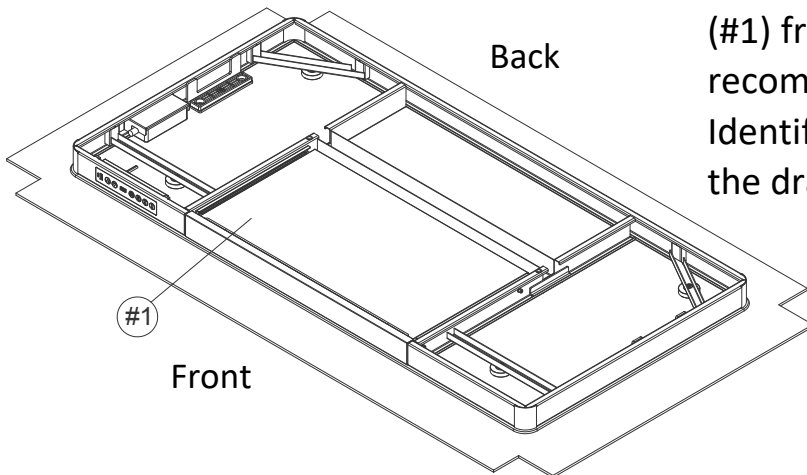

Step 3: Remove Top Frame (#1) from Box

Open the package, take out the Top Frame (#1) from the box, this item is heavy so we recommend 2 people for this step. Identify the front side from the back, note the drawer will be facing the front.

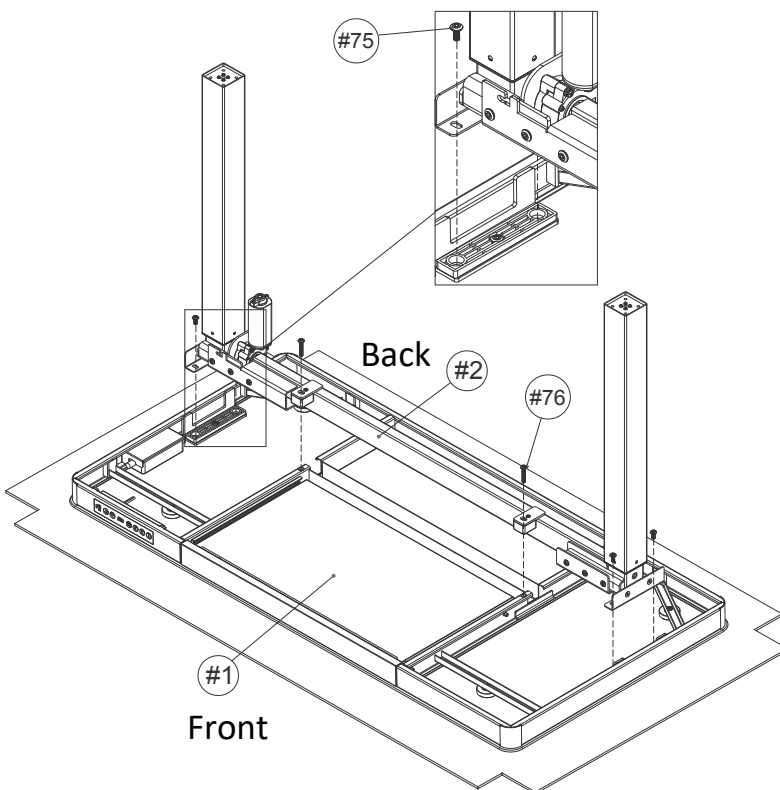


Step 4: Install Leg/Beam (#2) on the Top frame (#1).

1. Place the Leg/Beam (#2) on the Top Frame (#1), and align the screw holes of the center beam to the corresponding ones, using 2 pieces M6 x 35L screws (#76) to tighten. DO NOT fully tighten the screws yet.

2. Align the screw holes on the end of each side of the Leg/Beam (#2) with Top Frame (#1), use 4 pieces M6 x 14L screws (#75) to tighten. Tighten all screws fully. Refer to the image on the left.

Note: we recommend using 2 people for this step.

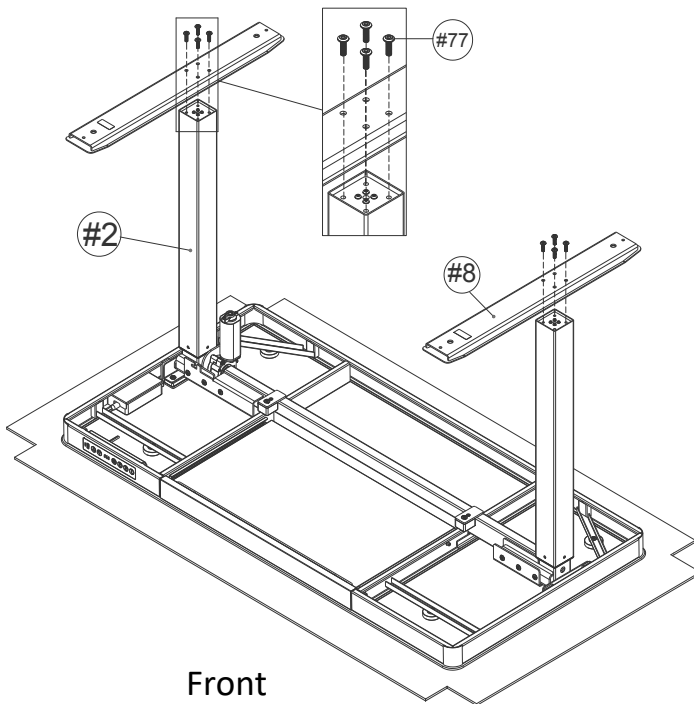

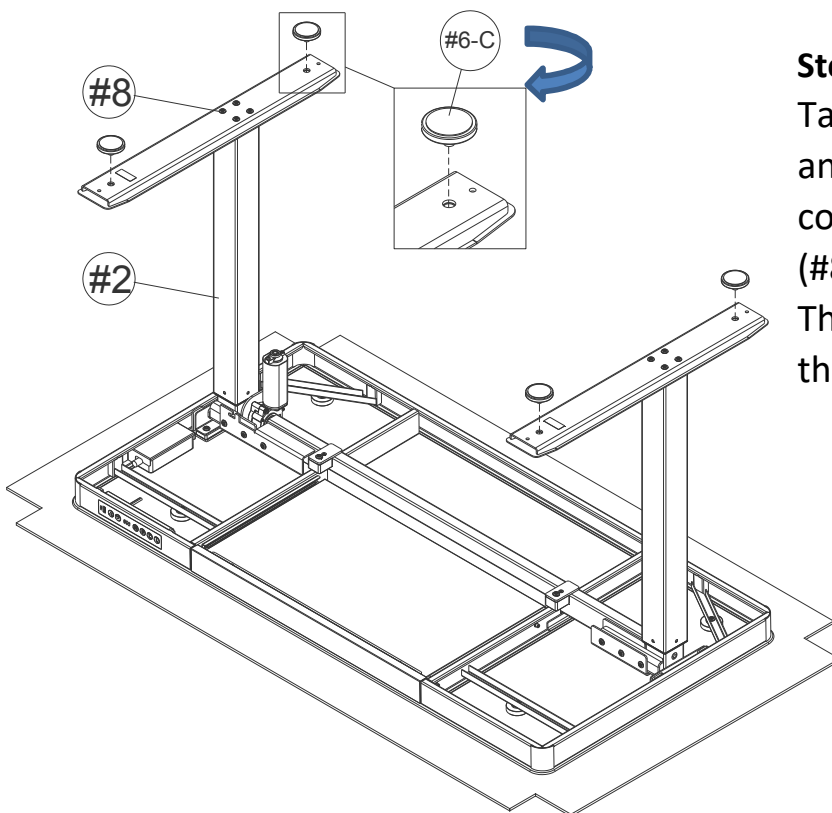

Step 5: Install the Feet (#8)

Use 8 pieces M6 x 20L screws (#77) to install the Feet (#8) on the Leg/Beam (#2).

Note: Please refer to the label on both feet to identify the front side of each foot.



Step 6: Install the Leveling Feet (#6-C).

Take 4 pieces of Leveling Feet (#6-C) and place 2 pieces on each corresponding location on the Feet (#8).

Then fasten them in place by turning them in a clockwise rotation.

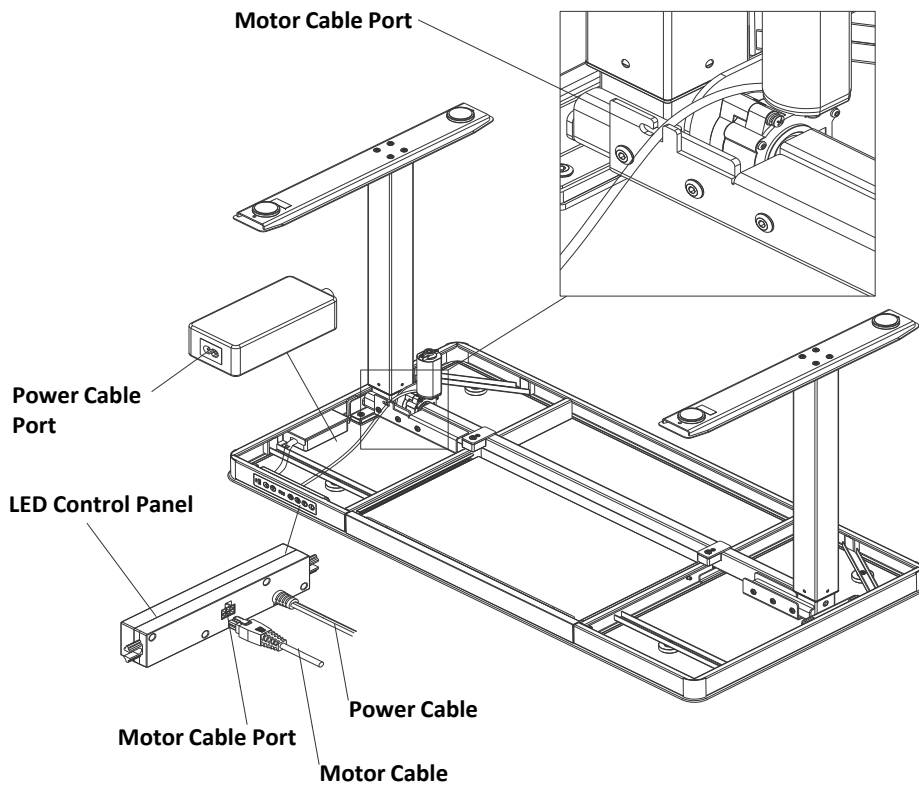

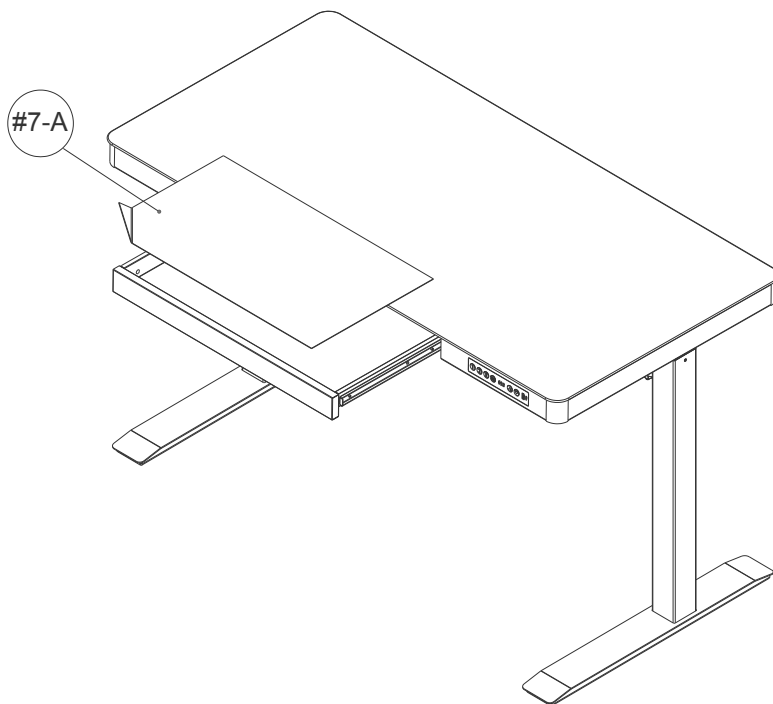

Step 7: Connect Motor Cable

Plug in the Motor Cable from leg beam to the LED Control Panel as displayed in left figure.



Step 8: Insert Drawer Mat (#7-A)

Using 2 people flip the desk back over on its legs.

Place the drawer mat (#7-A) inside the drawer compartment.

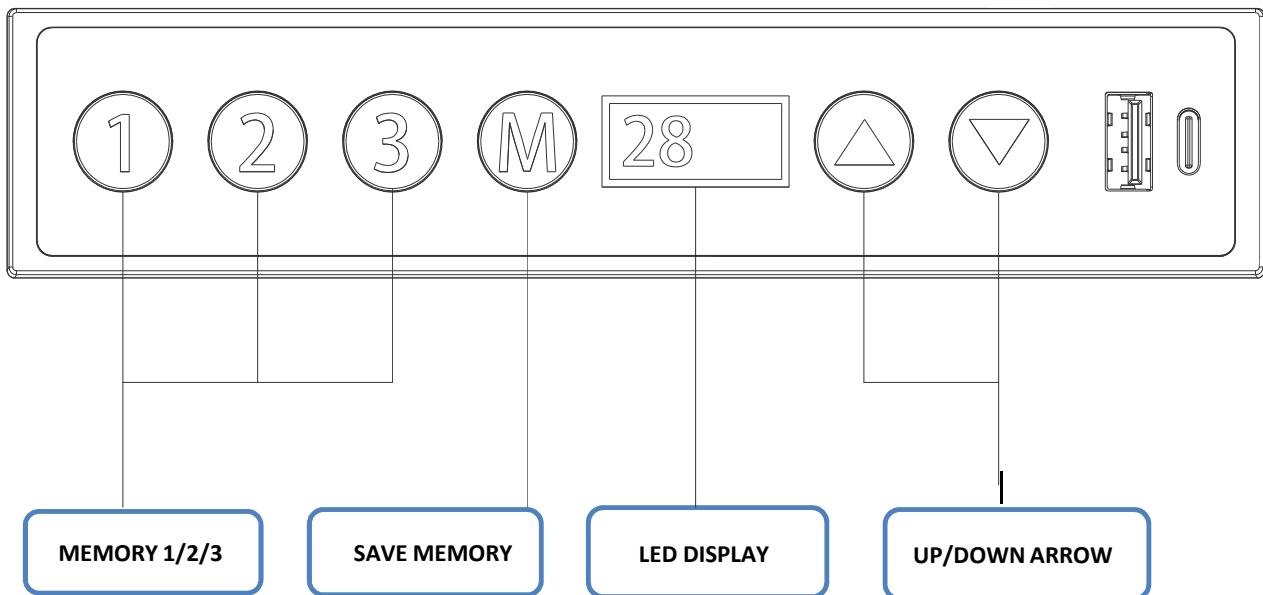

Post Setup Quick Start Instructions

How to Reset

Press and HOLD the  button until the unit reaches the lowest height. Continue to press and HOLD for about 5 seconds until you see a number (ie. 28) on the display AFTER it shows "rst" and makes a "beep-beep" sound, then release.





How to Adjust the Height

Press and HOLD either the  or  to adjust to your desired height of the desk.

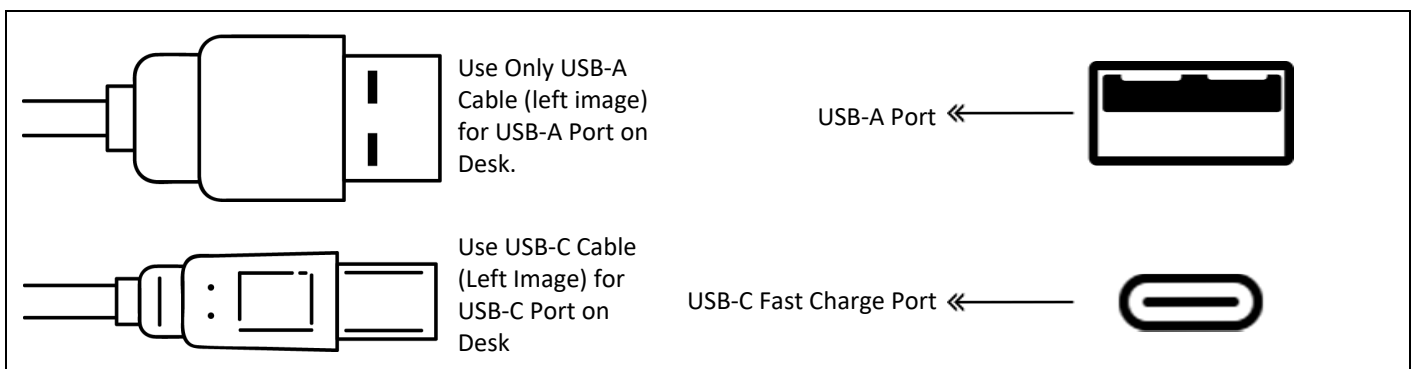
How to Save the Height in Memory

There are 3 available memory heights you can save - 1, 2 & 3. Adjust the desk to your desired height and press the "M" button to display "S-". While "S" is flashing, select any of 1, 2 or 3 number button. When a memory is saved, you will hear "beep-beep" sound. By repeating the same steps, you can save or override an old saved memory with a new height.

How to Lock/Unlock the LED Control Panel

First adjust the desk height to your desired lock height. Then press and HOLD the  and  together for about 5 seconds until "Loc" is displayed. At this moment, the LED Control Panel is locked and the desk height can't be adjusted. In order to unlock, press and HOLD the  and  buttons together for about 5 seconds until a number (previously locked height) is displayed.
